2. News of the week

New consultation on the Adaptation Strategy – European Commission

The European Commission has published a new consultation for the EU strategy on adaptation to climate change. The effects of climate changes have already been visible in Europe, with examples like water shortages creating obstacles to economic activity human livelihood. Stakeholders from all backgrounds are then invited to contribute with feedbacks on how the EU should prepare its citizens and activities.

New projects for low-carbon technologies received funding under the scope of the EIC – European Commission

Among the 35 projects awarded with grants from the European Innovation Council, 12 pertain to the category "Breakthrough zero-emissions energy generation for full decarbonisation". These projects have different scopes, from photoelectrical cells mimicking photosintes to hydrogen-driven heat generation and zero-emission energy storage systems. The projects are funded through the EIC with money from the Horizon 2020 programme.

Commission publishes study on policy recommendations for energy storage – European Commission

Last week the Commission presented an independent, Commission-funded study on the development of energy storage in the EU. The report lists a series of policy recommendations to be adopted, in the years to come, in order to increase the capacity of the EU's energy storage sector. Among these, the Commission encourages Member States to develop specific strategies for energy storage, to include the topic in their NECPs and to provide economic support to higher readiness-level storage technologies.

The Committee of Regions, in sight of the current consultation on the Climate Pact, has published a survey on the role that LRAs will play in the challenge to make the EU climate neutral. The findings of the questionnaire will feed into a forthcoming CoR opinion on the Climate Pact being drafted by the Rapporteur Rafał Trzaskowski.
