France and the EU share a wide consensus regarding the new technologies that need to be developed to support the decarbonisation of the economy, whilst ensuring energy security and industrial sovereignty.

This common vision translates into a high level of participation by the French energy and ecological transition research ecosystem in European research funding schemes (Horizon Europe, CETP, EURATOM,...). France is also a major contributor to the SET Plan objectives, which aim at shaping integrated European research priorities in the field of low-carbon energy.

Nevertheless, some limits may arise, due for instance to fragmentation of funding instruments (Horizon Europe, ANR, regional funds, France 2030) which create administrative complexity and lead, in the worst case, to incompatibilities.

The participants to the round table will be requested to share their thoughts on what should be done to improve coordination between European and national roadmaps, align funding priorities, promote cross-border cooperations, ...
